## 2-1-1 EAST TEXAS

- United Way of Smith County works in collaboration with the Health and Human Services Commission of Texas to oversee **2-1-1 East Texas**.
- By dialing **2-1-1**, individuals get the **help they need** in finding resources like healthcare, food, shelter, medical assistance, government information, support groups, job training and more.
- 2-1-1 East Texas is available in **all languages**, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. In doing this 2-1-1 East Texas takes over **90,000** calls a year.
